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Elaine Cass – Another thing we can do to improve safeguarding is to support the people that are posing a risk to vulnerable people.

I mean obviously there are vulnerable people who are criminals but sometimes there are people with anti-social behaviour who themselves have problems so they may have drug or alcohol problems, or they may have mental health problems – and they may themselves pose a risk to other vulnerable people.

And it's through support for them, the right type of support, that we can then reduce their behaviours and that will protect people from that.
