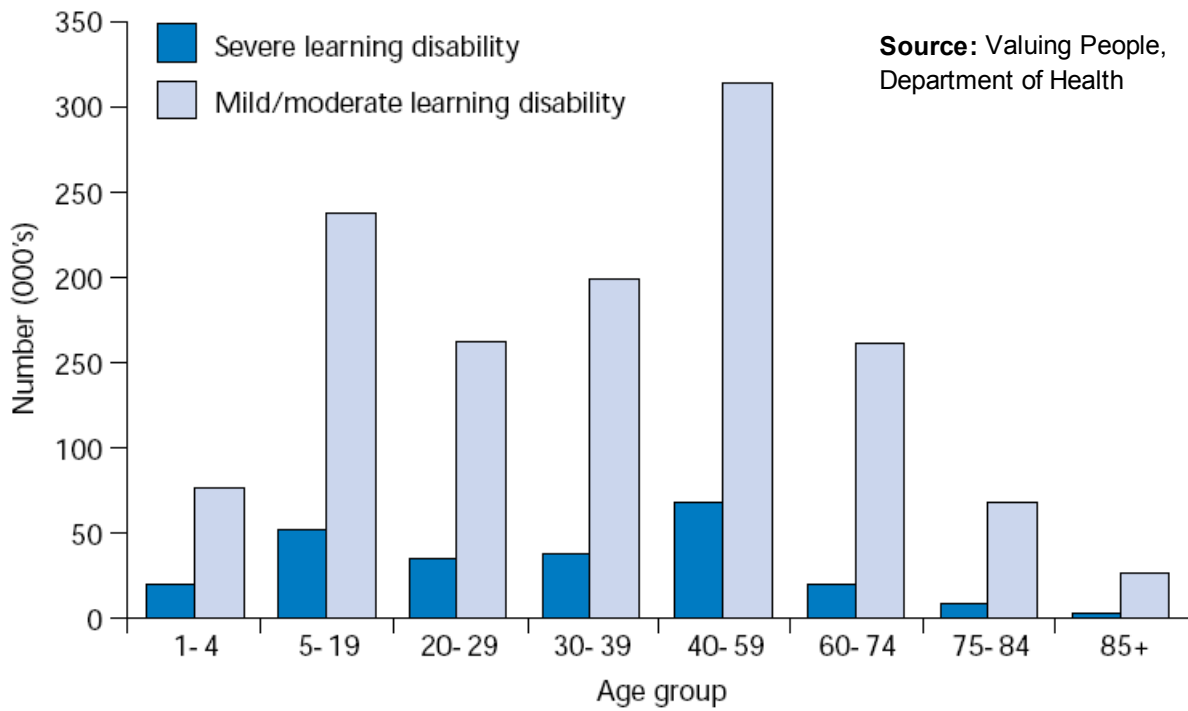
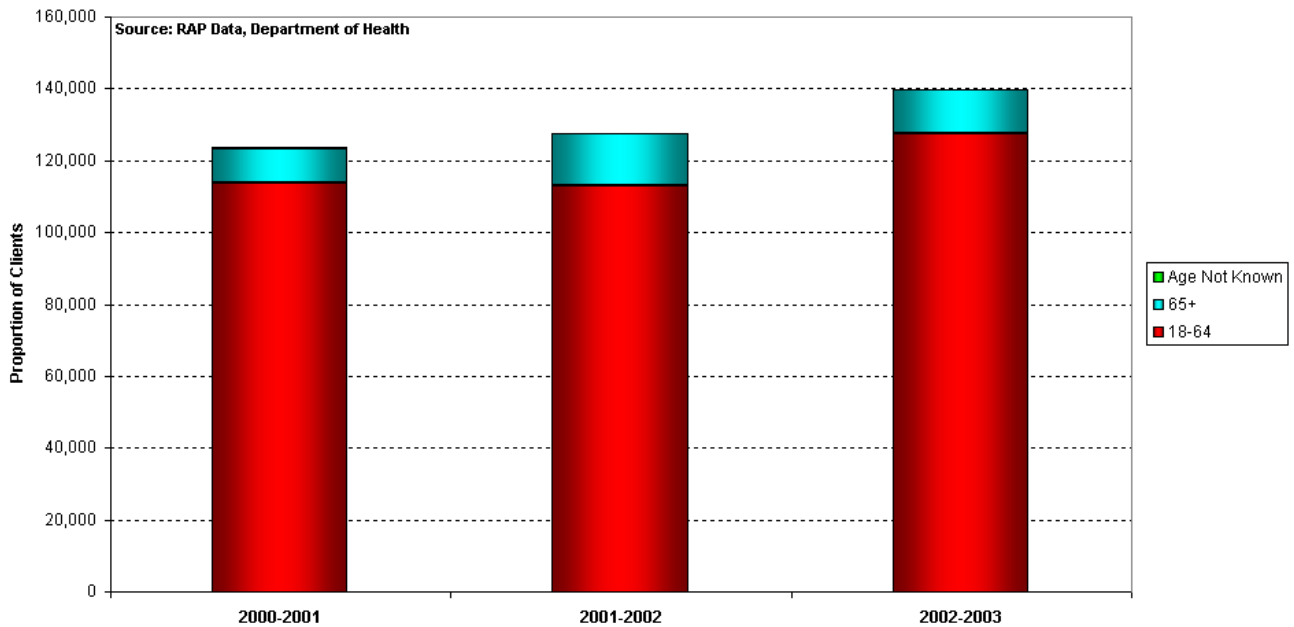


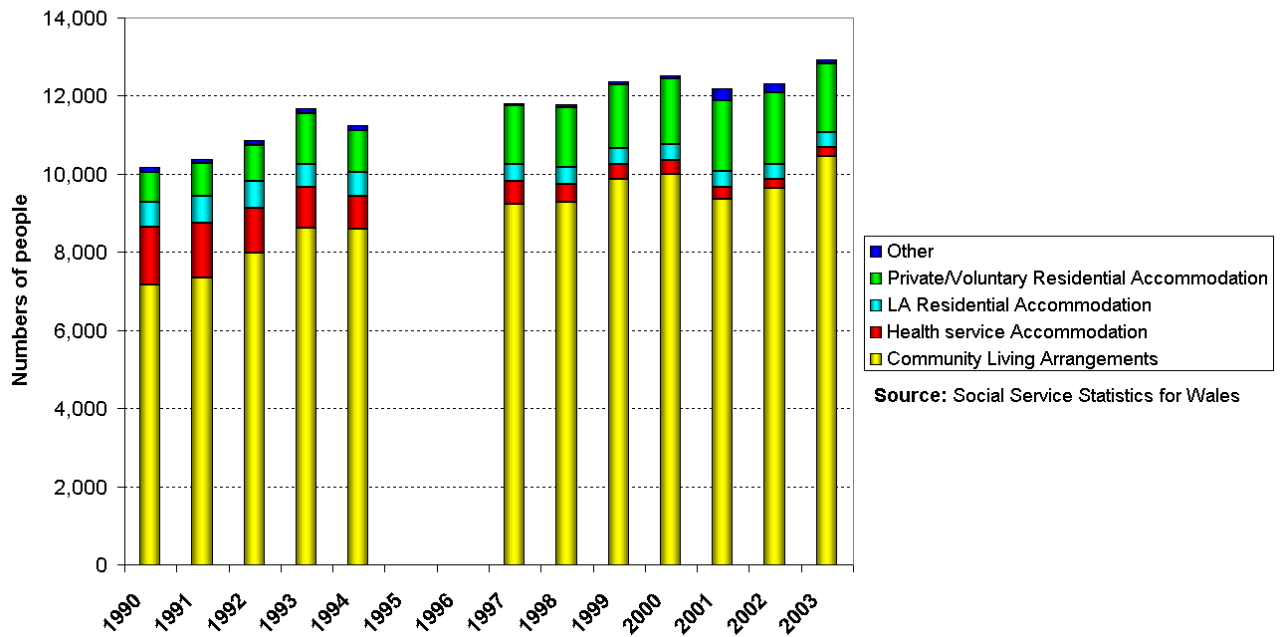
**Figure 8.1 - England Number of people with learning disabilities, 1999**



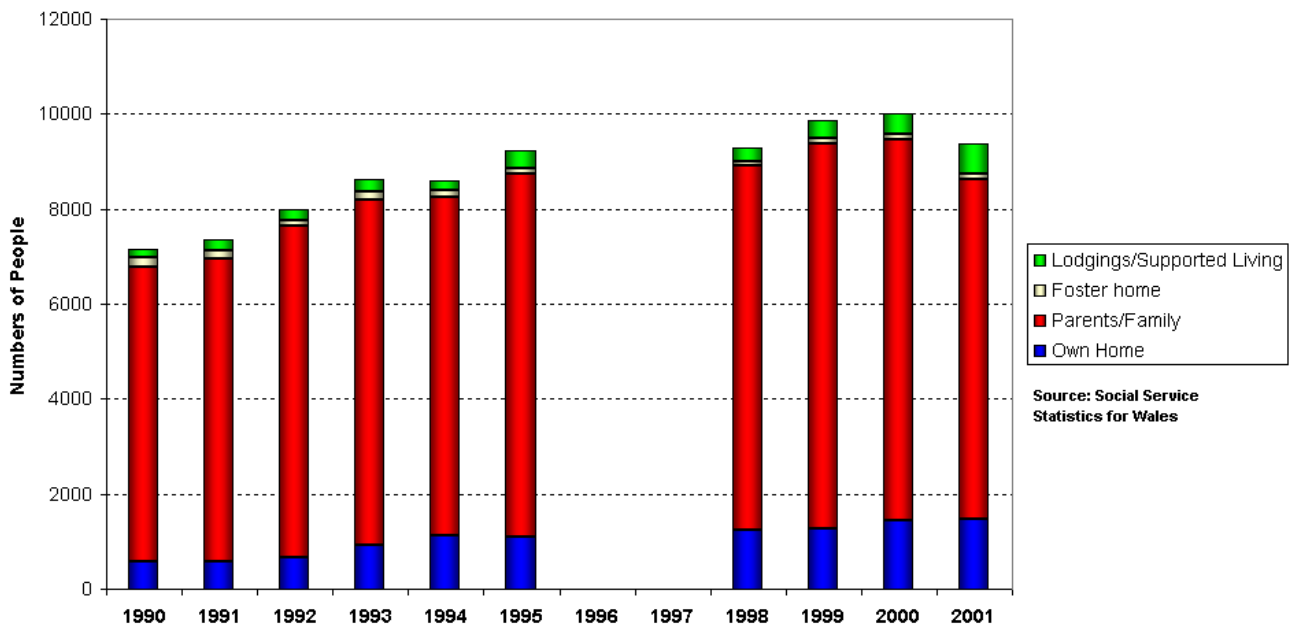
**Figure 8.2 - England: Number of Learning Disabled Clients Receiving Services by Age 2000-2001 to 2002-2003**



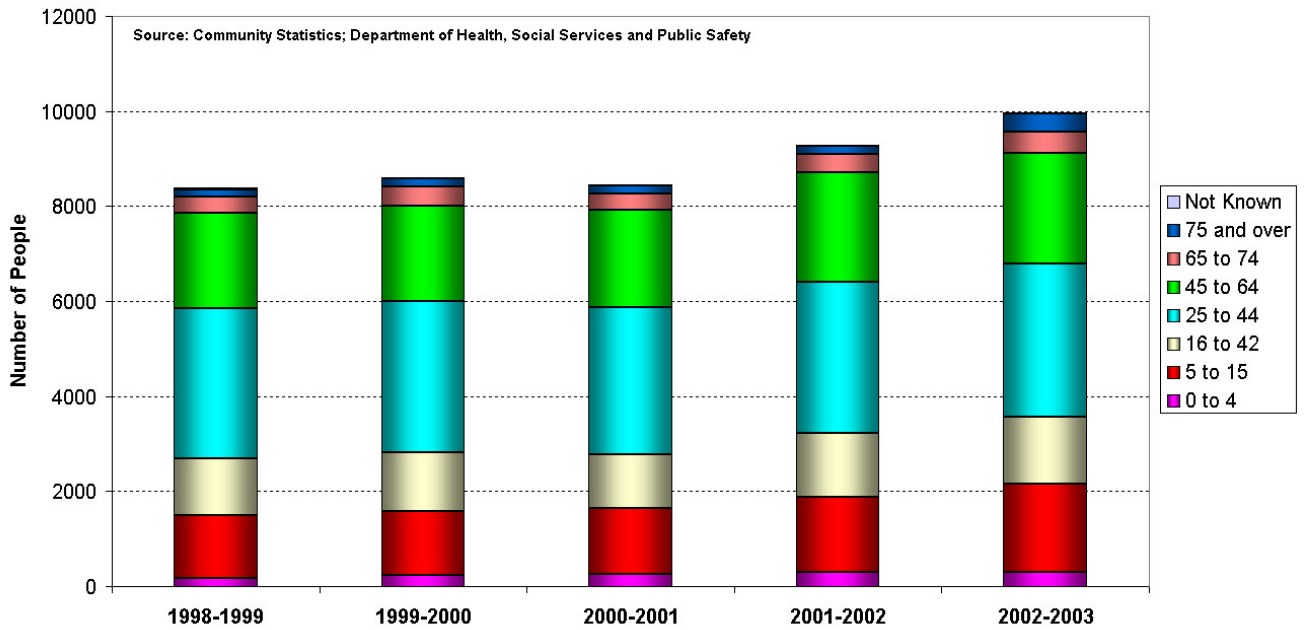
**Figure 8.3 - Wales: Numbers of People in Learning Disabilities Registers at 31st March by Living Arrangements 1990-2003**



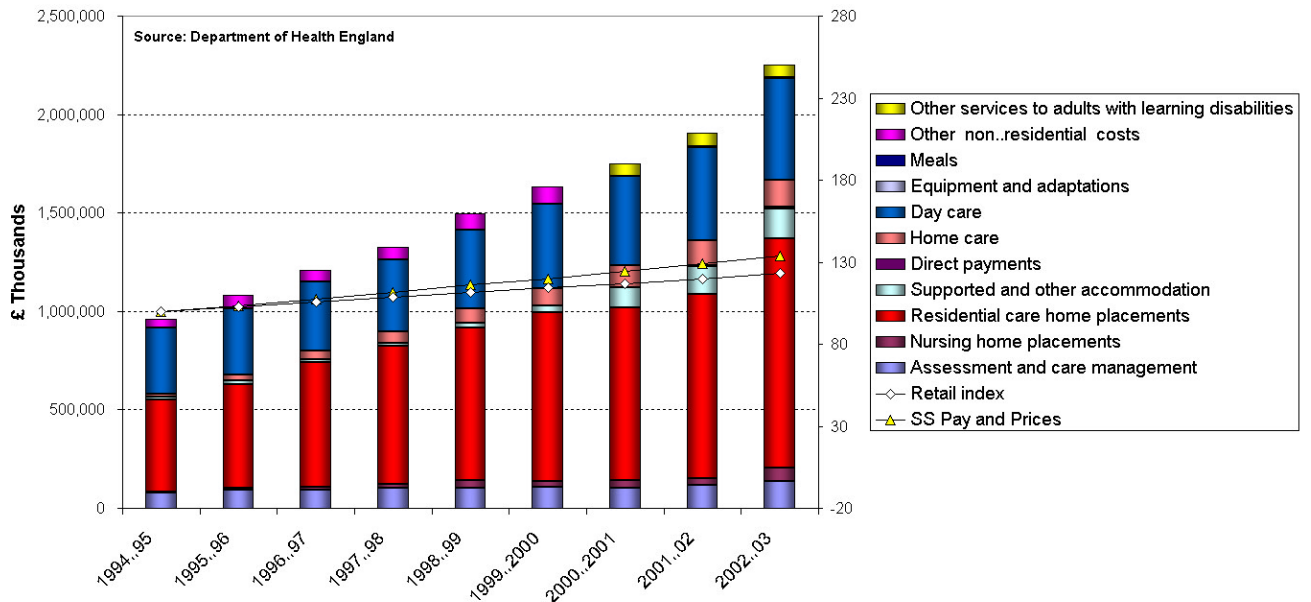
**Figure 8.4 Wales: Numbers of People with Learning Disabilities at 31st March Living in the Community by Place of Living 1990-2001**



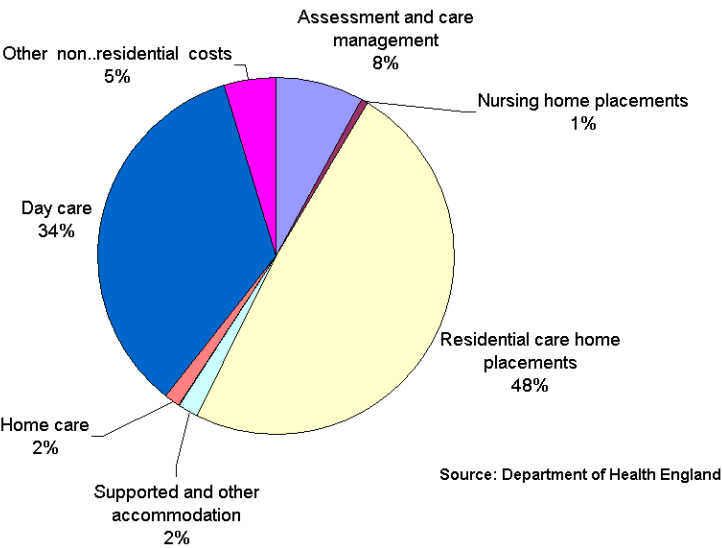
**Figure 8.5 - Northern Ireland: Number of People with Learning Disability who had Contact with Providers at 31st March by Age 1998-1999 to 2002-2003**



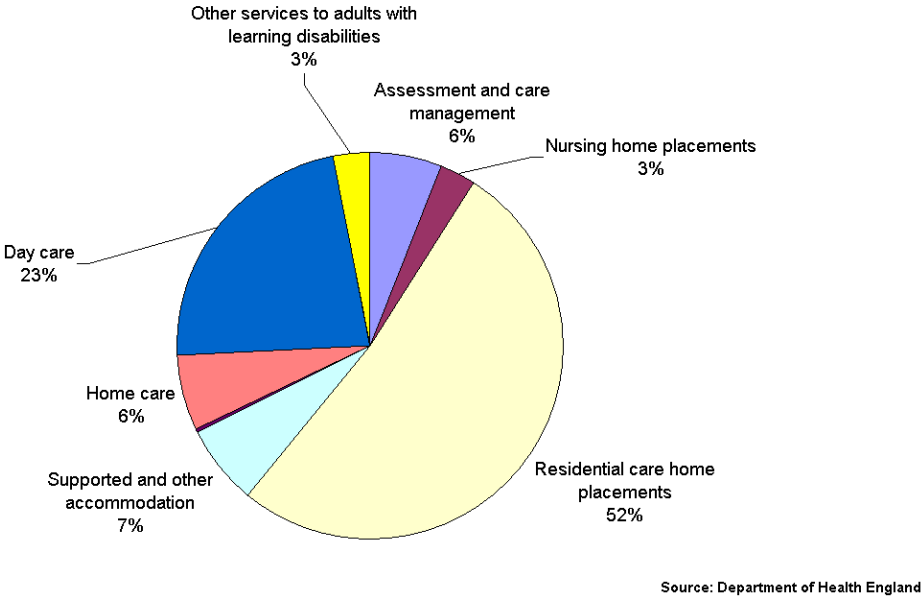
**Figure 8.6 - England: Gross Expenditure in Social Services for Adults under 65 with Learning Disabilities 1994-1995 to 2002-2003**



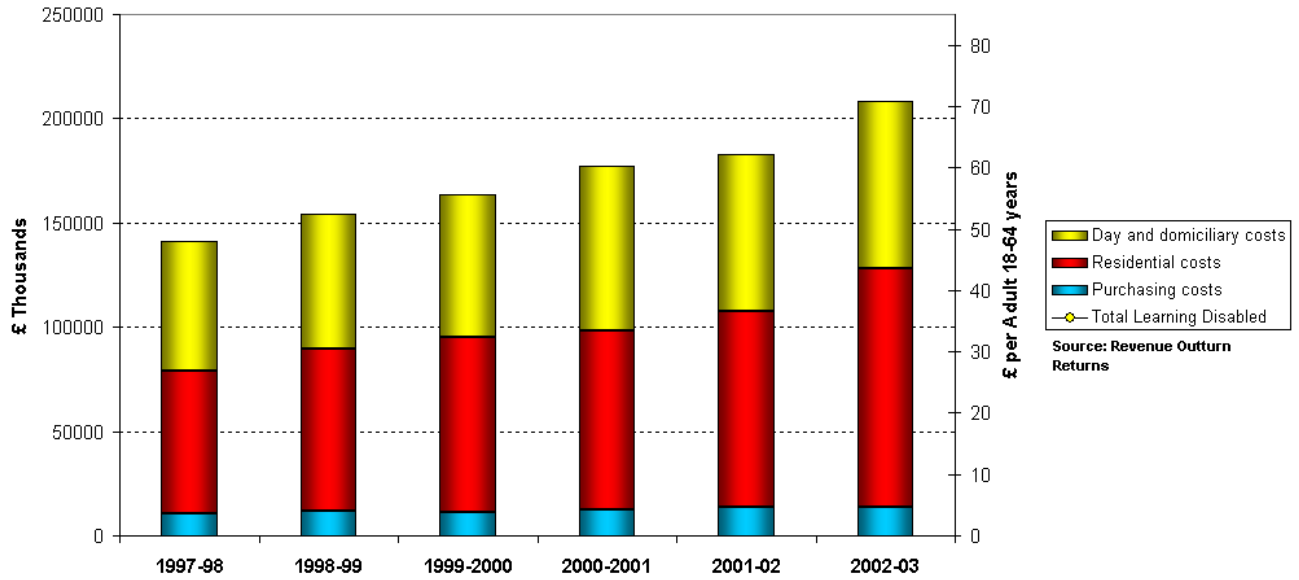
**Figure 8.7 England: Proportional Expenditure in Social Services for Adults under 64 with Learning Disabilities 1994 to 1995**

**Figure 8.10 Wales: Proportional expenditure in social services for learning disabilities 1997-98**

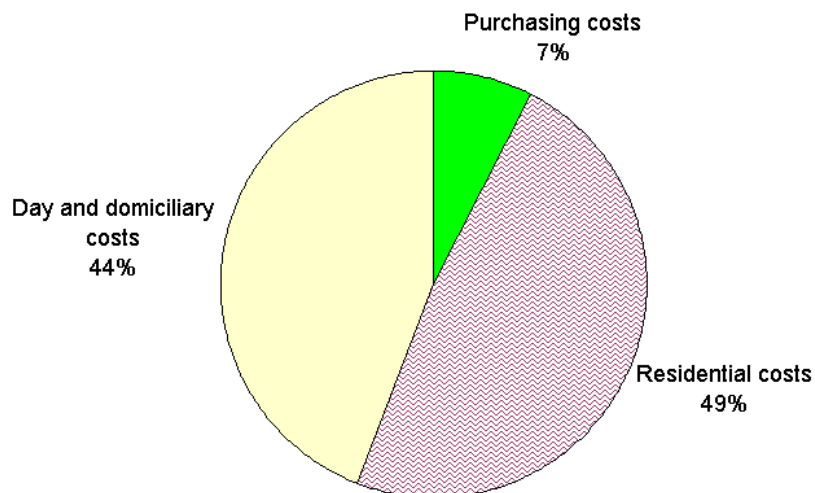
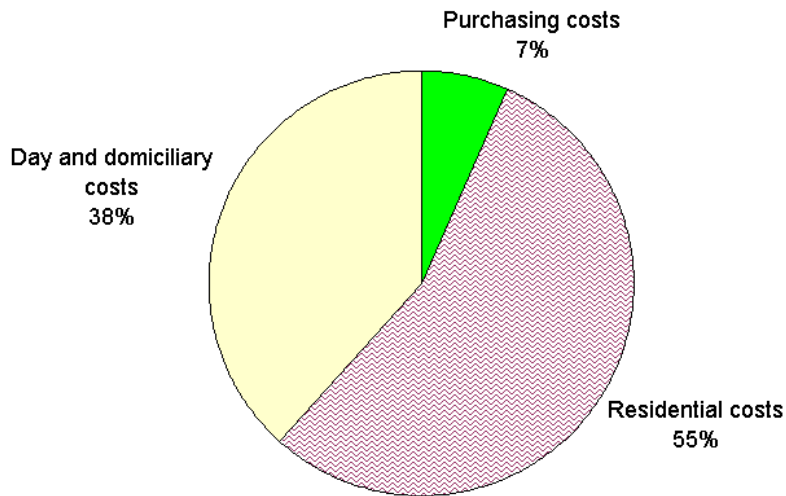
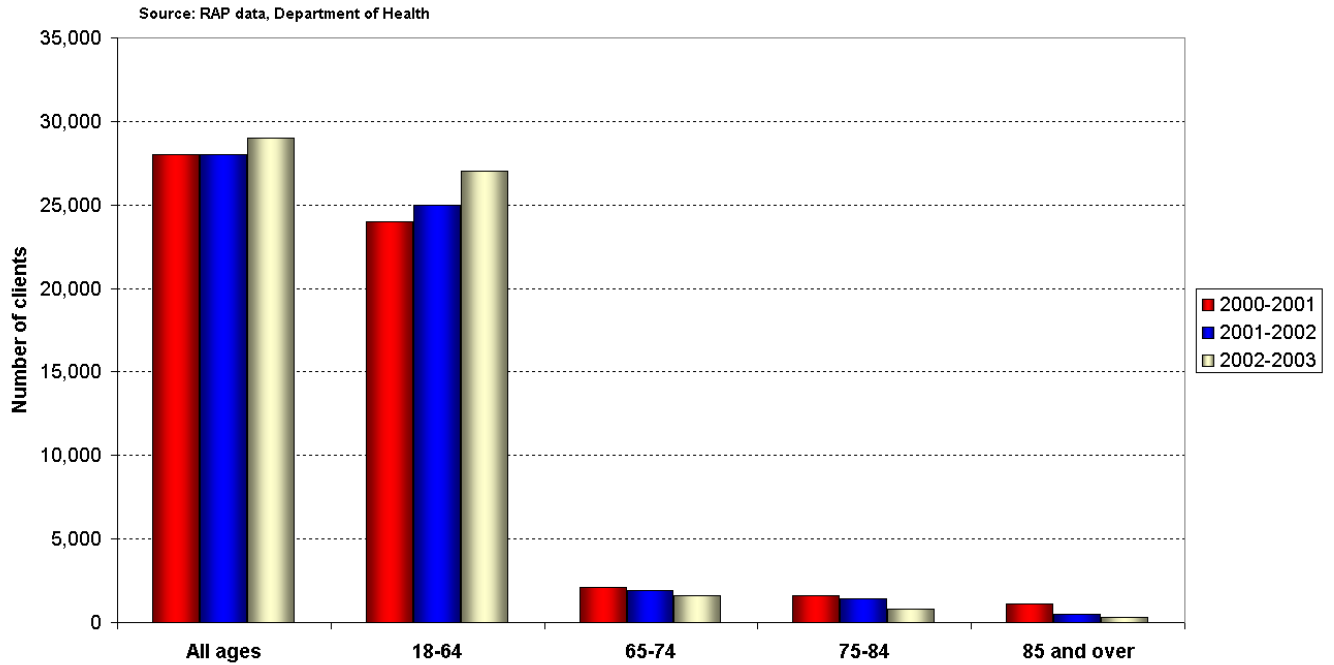


Figure 8.11 Wales: Proportional expenditure in social services for learning disabilities 2002-03

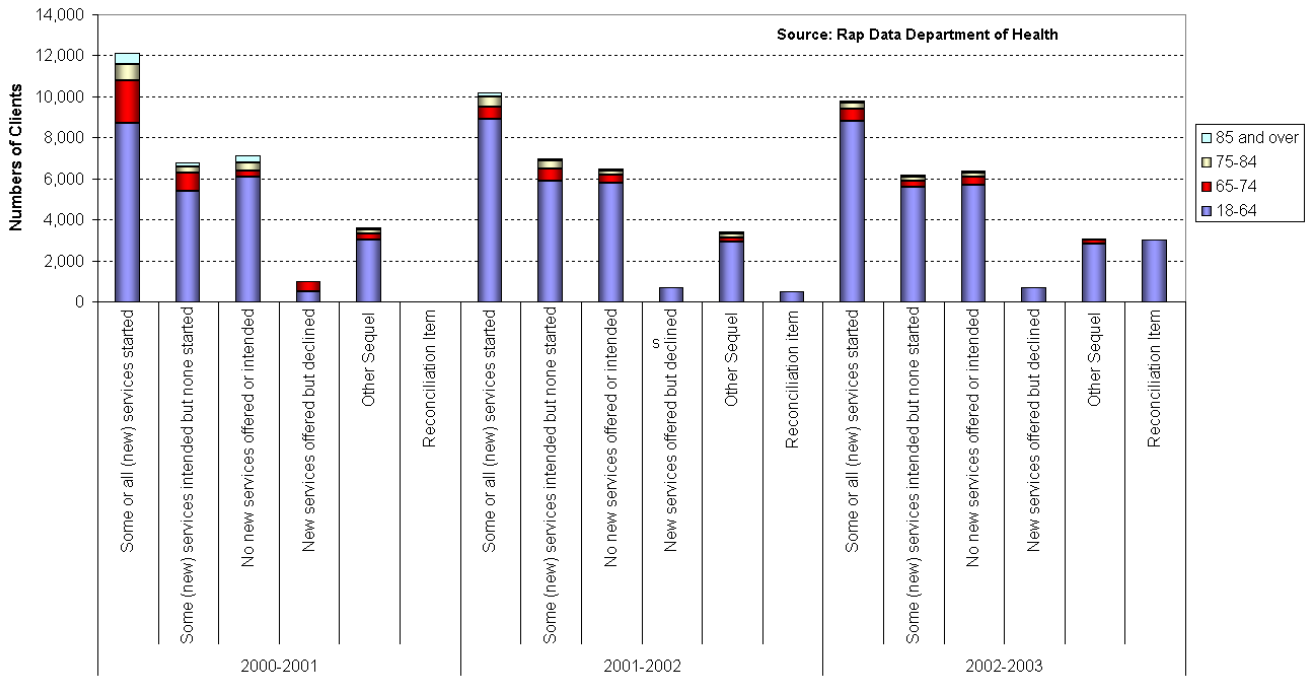

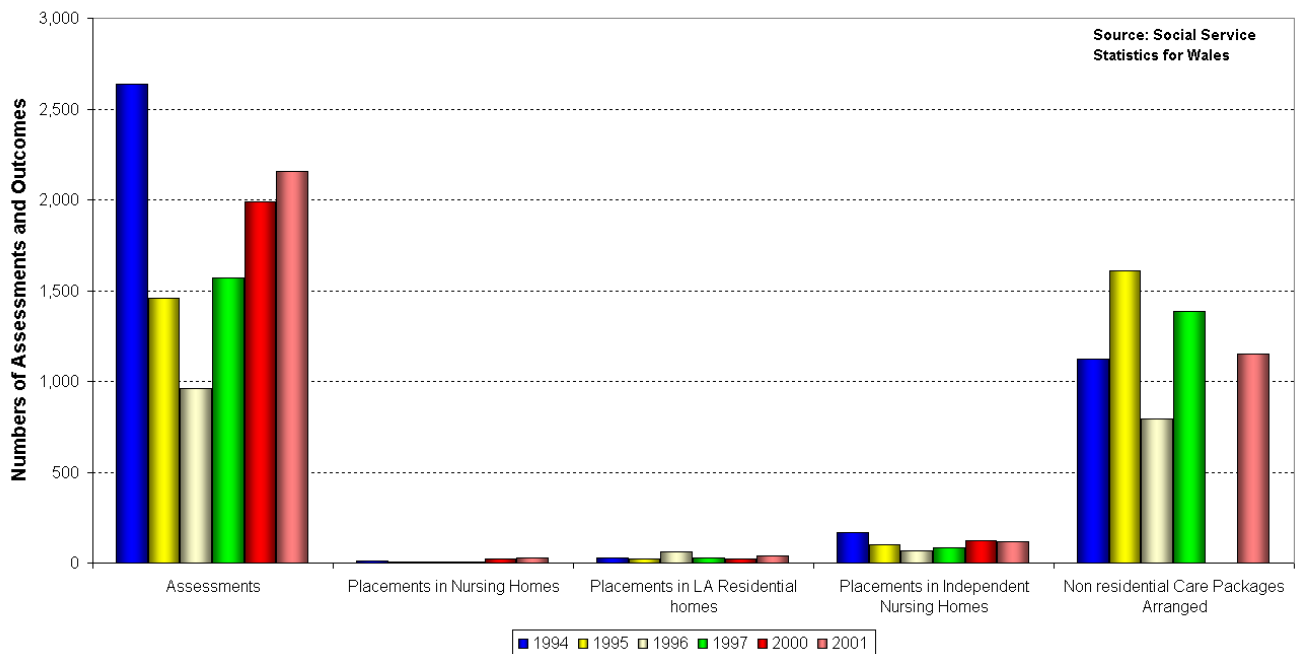
Figure 8.12 England: Estimated number of Learning Disability clients with Completed Assessments by Age 2000-2001 to 2002-2003



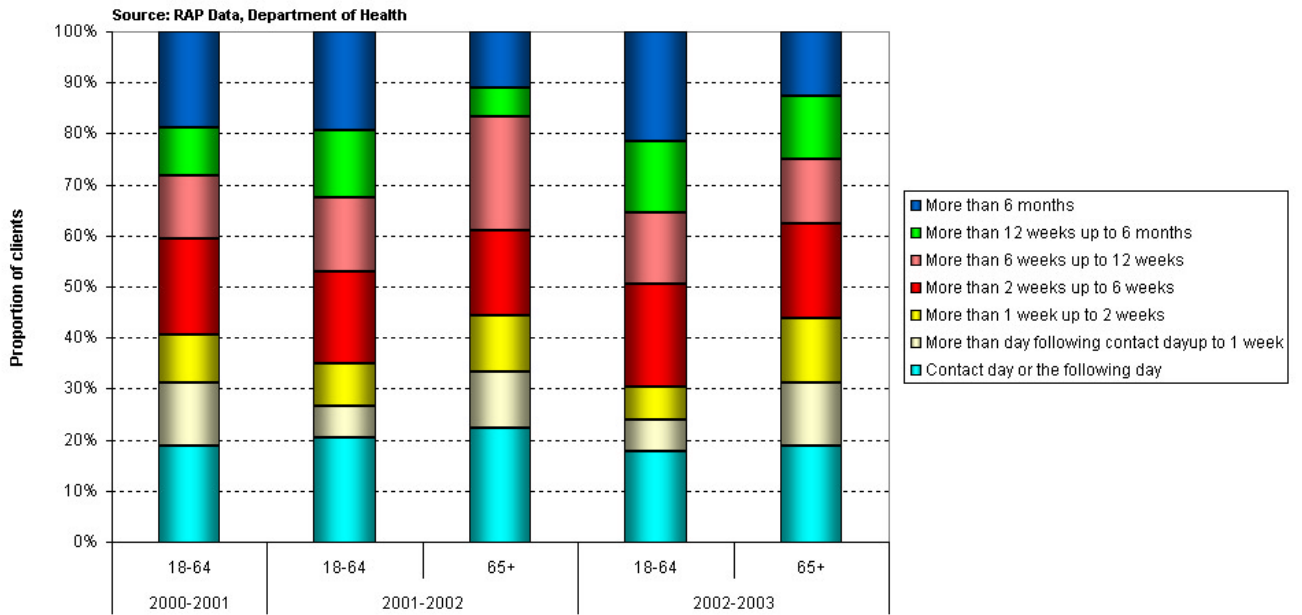
**Figure 8.13 England: Number of Learning Disability Clients with Completed Assessments, by Age and Anticipated Sequel to Assessment 2000-2001 to 2002-2003**



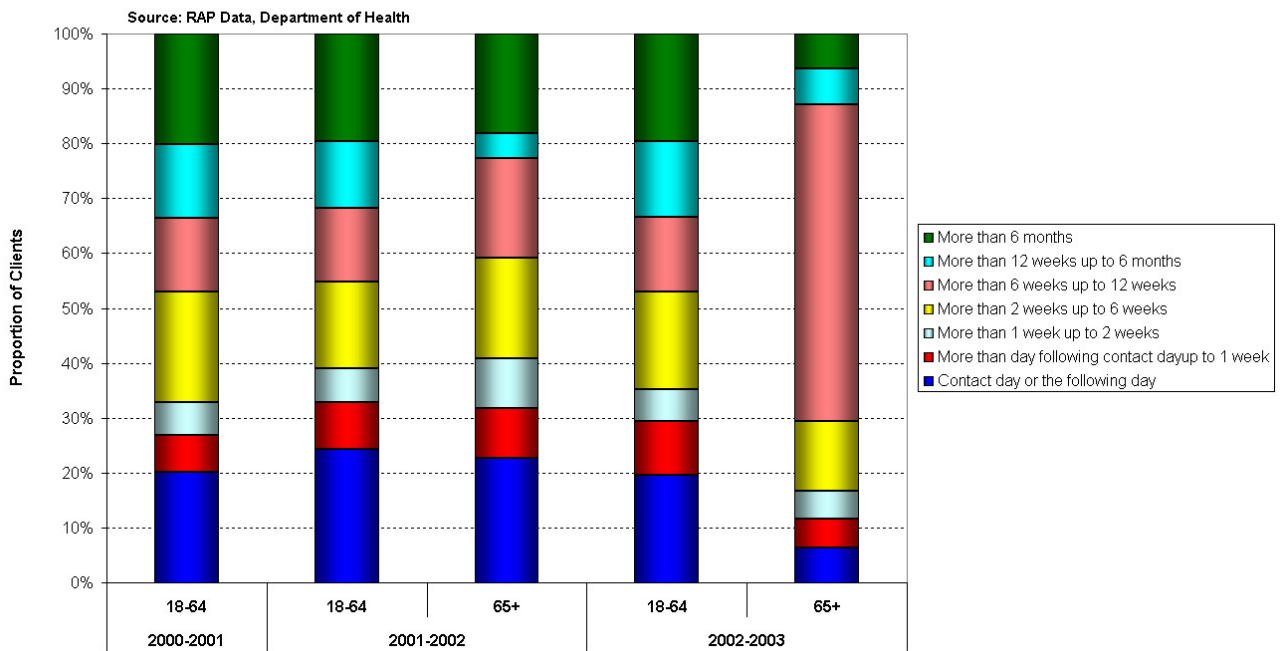
**Figure 8.14 Wales: Number of Assessments and Outcomes for People with Learning Disabilities 1994-2001**



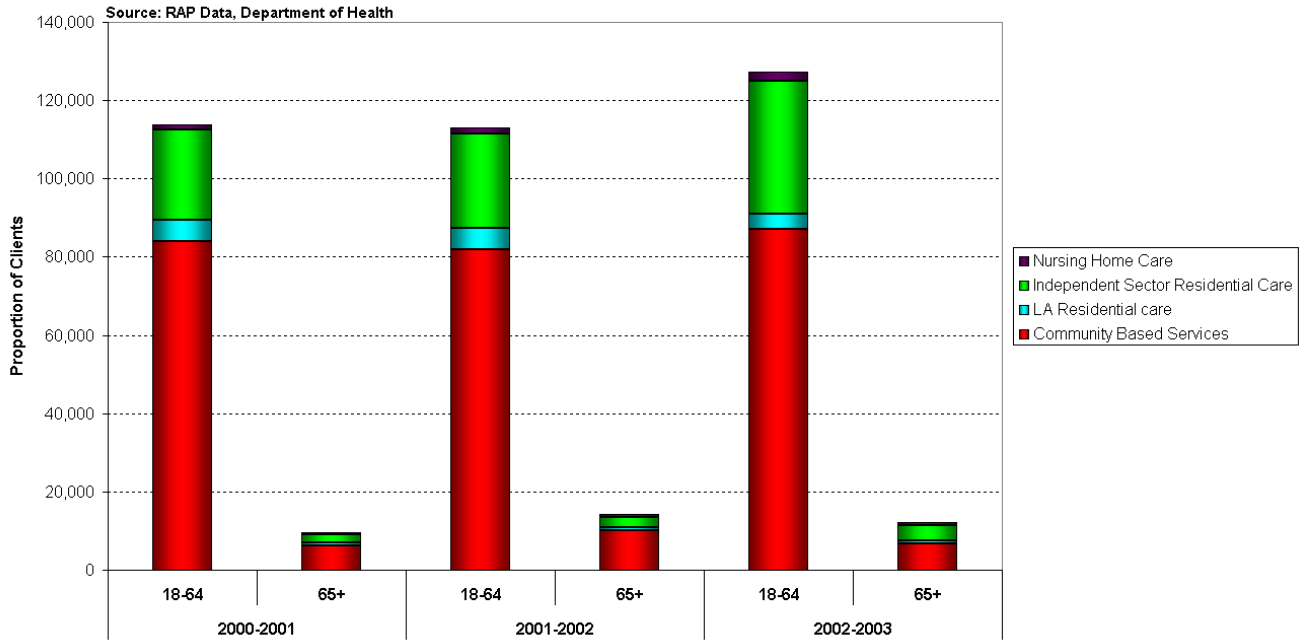
**Figure 8.15 England: Length of Time for Learning Disability Clients from First Contact to Completed Assessment for new clients for whom Assessments were completed by Age group 2000-2001 to 2002-2003**



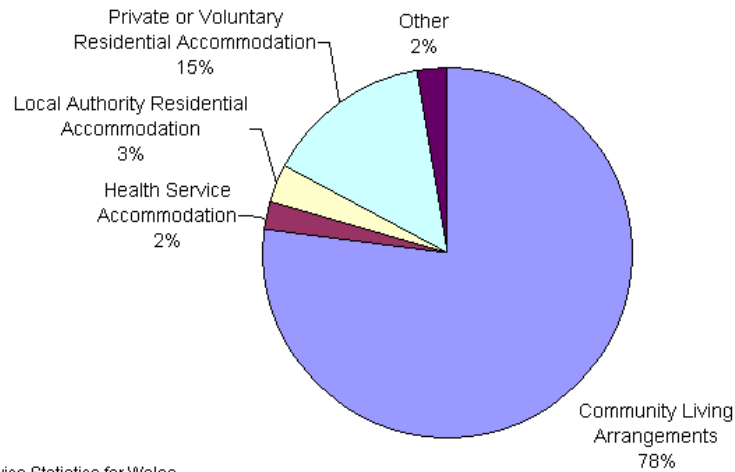
**Figure 8.16 England: Length of Time from First Contact to First Service for Learning Disabled Clients by Age 2000-2001 to 2002-2003**



**Figure 8.17 England: Learning Disabled Clients Receiving Services following Assessment by Service Type and Age 2000-2001 to 2002-2003**

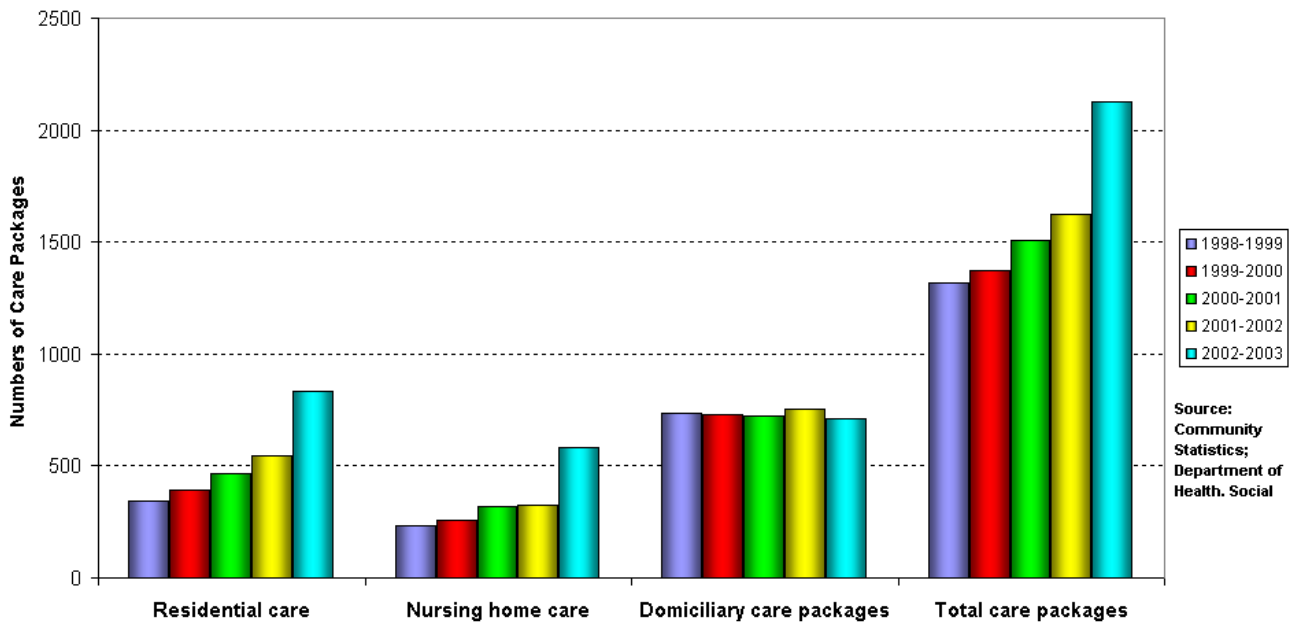


**Figure 8.18 Wales: People with Learning Disabilities on the Register by Type of Living Arrangements at 31st March 2001**

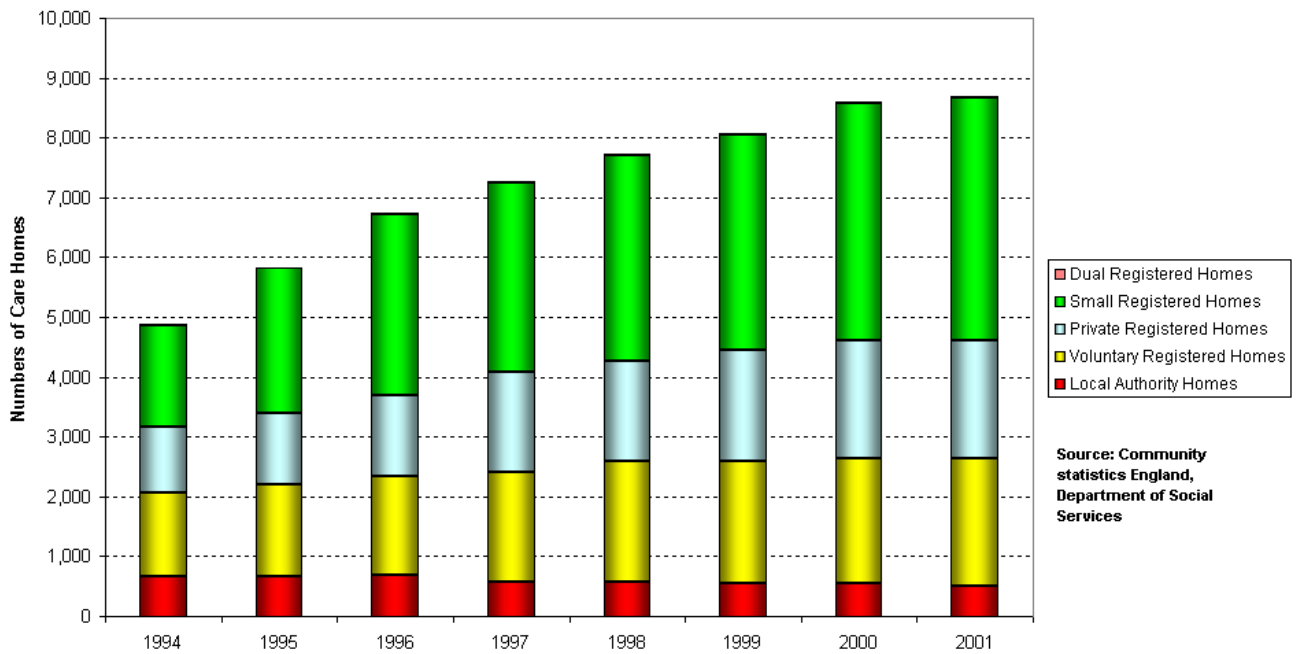

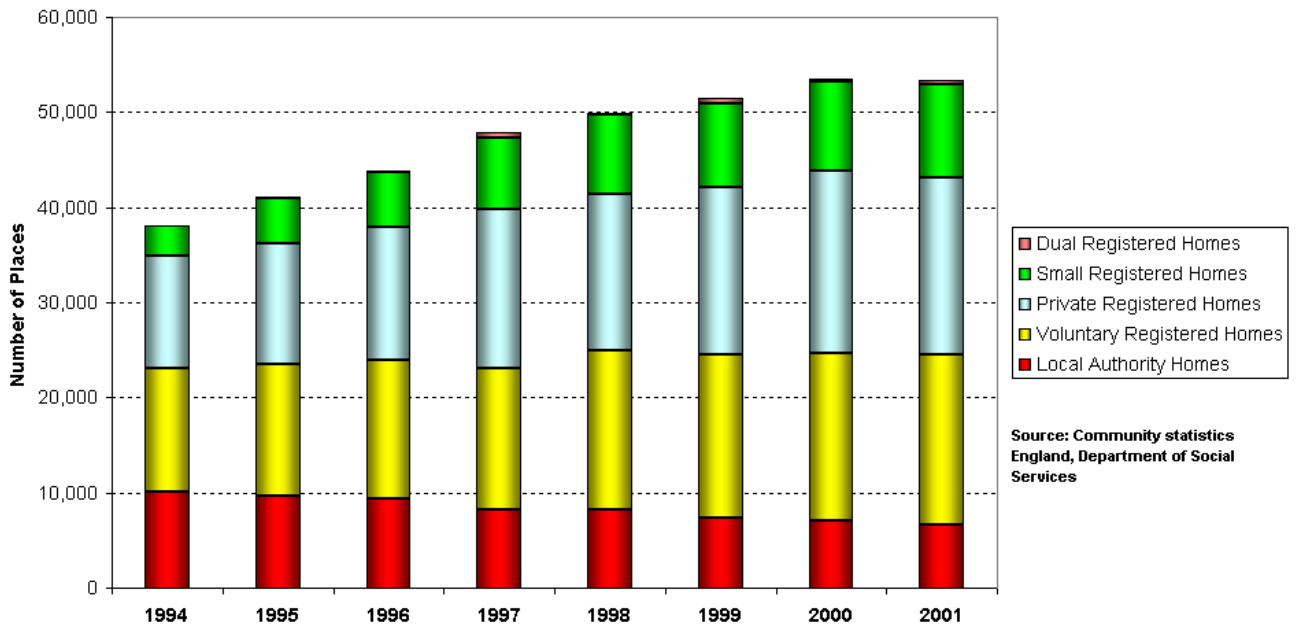
**Figure 8.19 Northern Ireland: Numbers of Care Packages in Effect for People with Learning Disabilities at 31st March by Care Type and Sector**



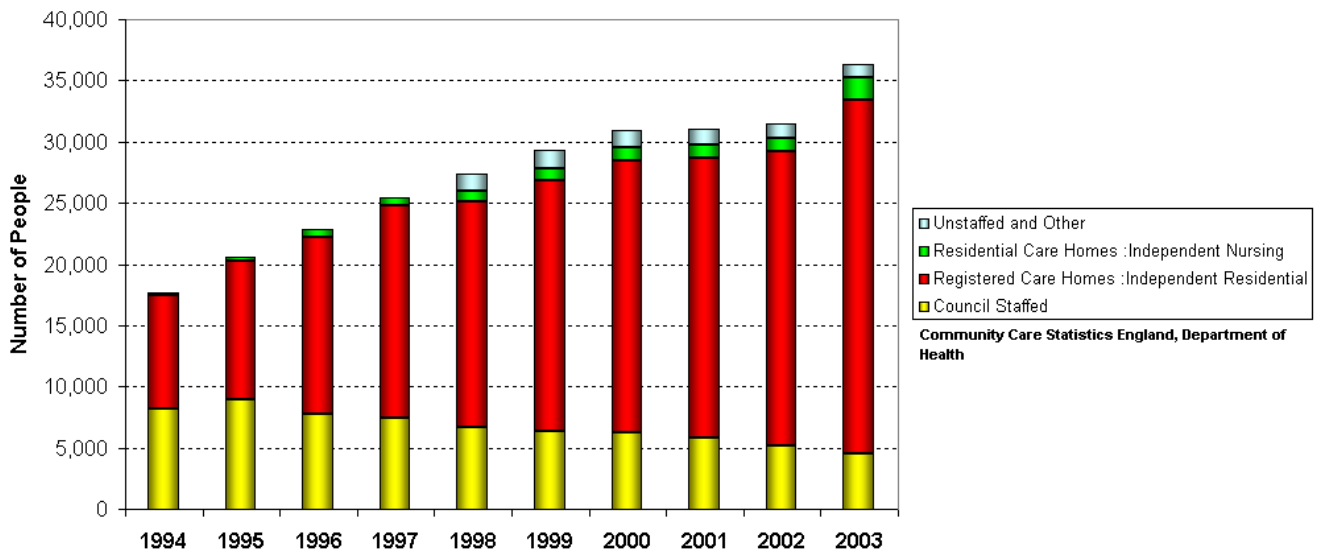
**Figure 8.20 England: Numbers of Residential Care Homes for Learning Disabled Adults by Type of Accommodation 1994-2001**



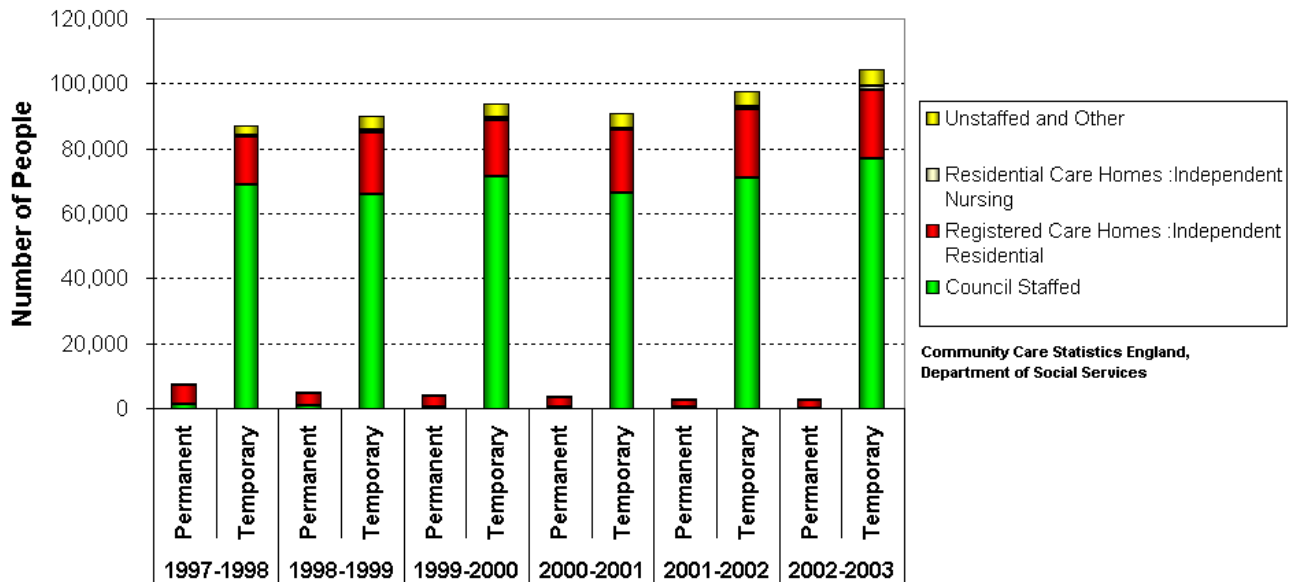
**Figure 8.21 England: Residential Places in Residential Care Homes for Adults with Learning Disability by Type of Accommodation 1994-2001**

**Figure 8.24 Wales: Number of Homes, Places and Supported Residents for People with Learning Disabilities at 31st March 1980-2001**

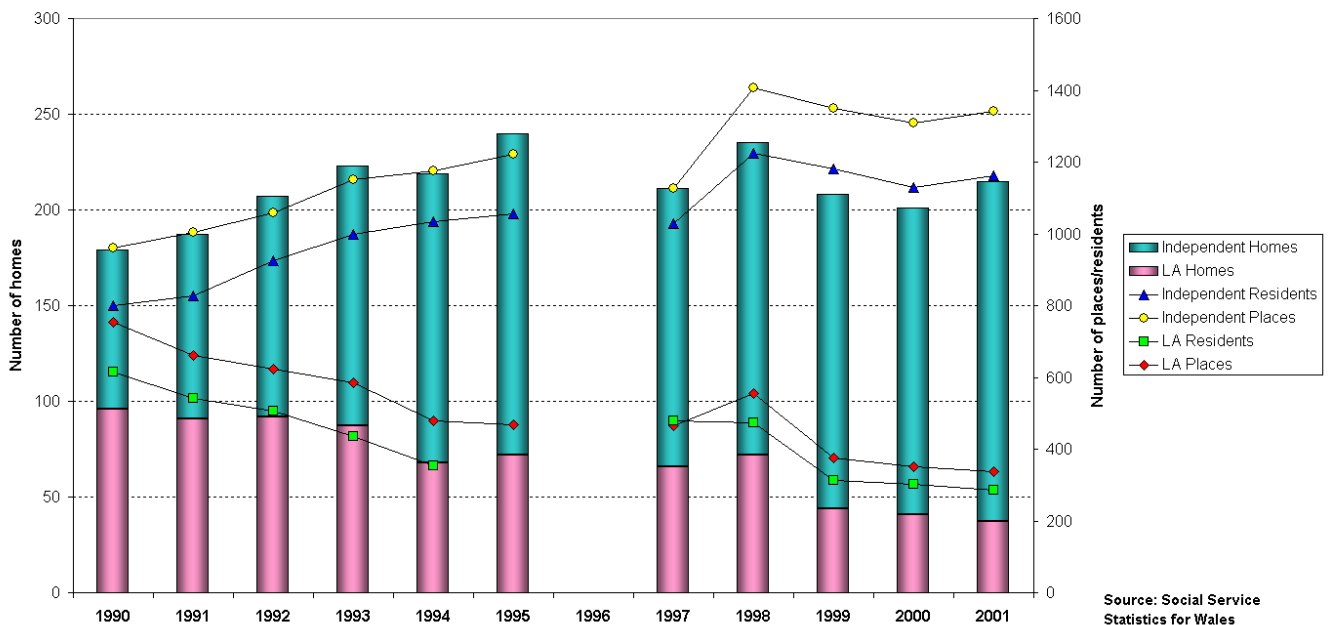




Figure 8.27 Northern Ireland: Numbers of People with Learning Disabilities receiving Home Help and Meals on Wheels Service as at 31st March 1998-1999 to 2002-2003

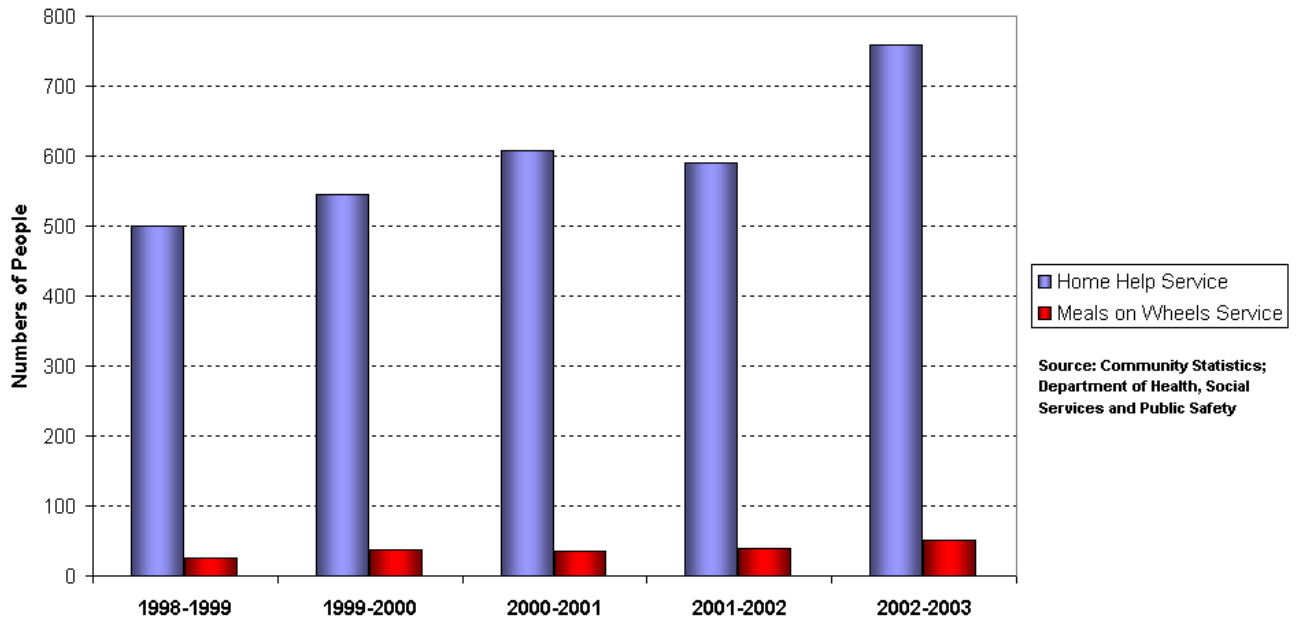
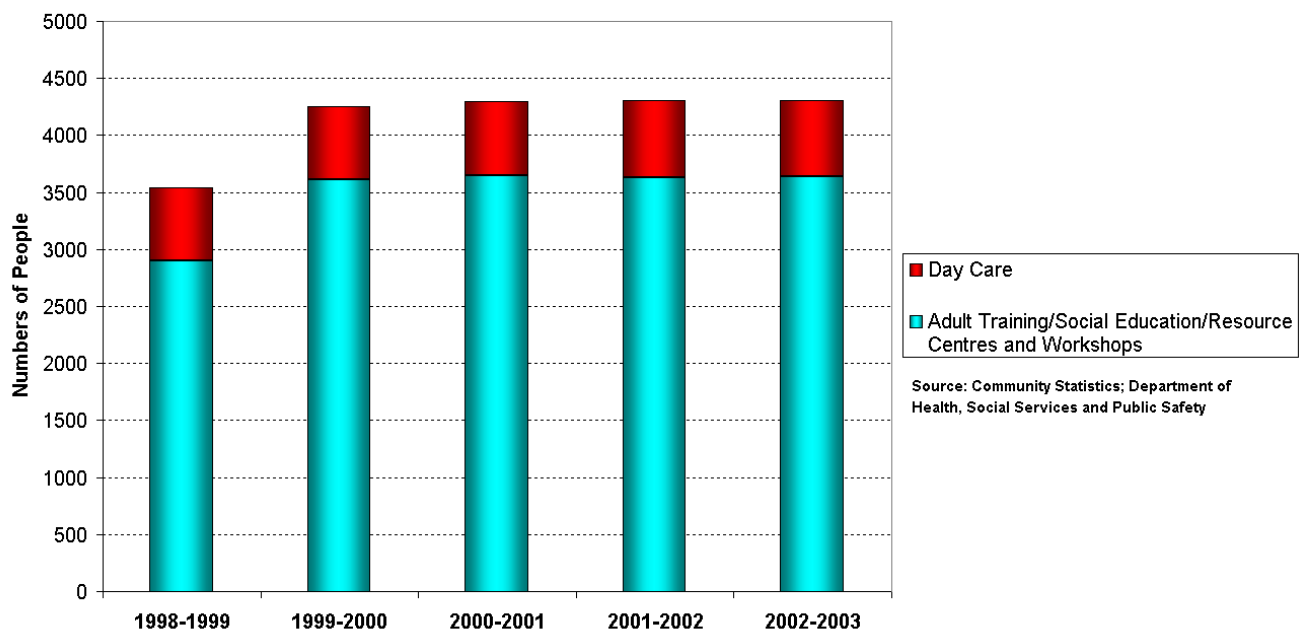
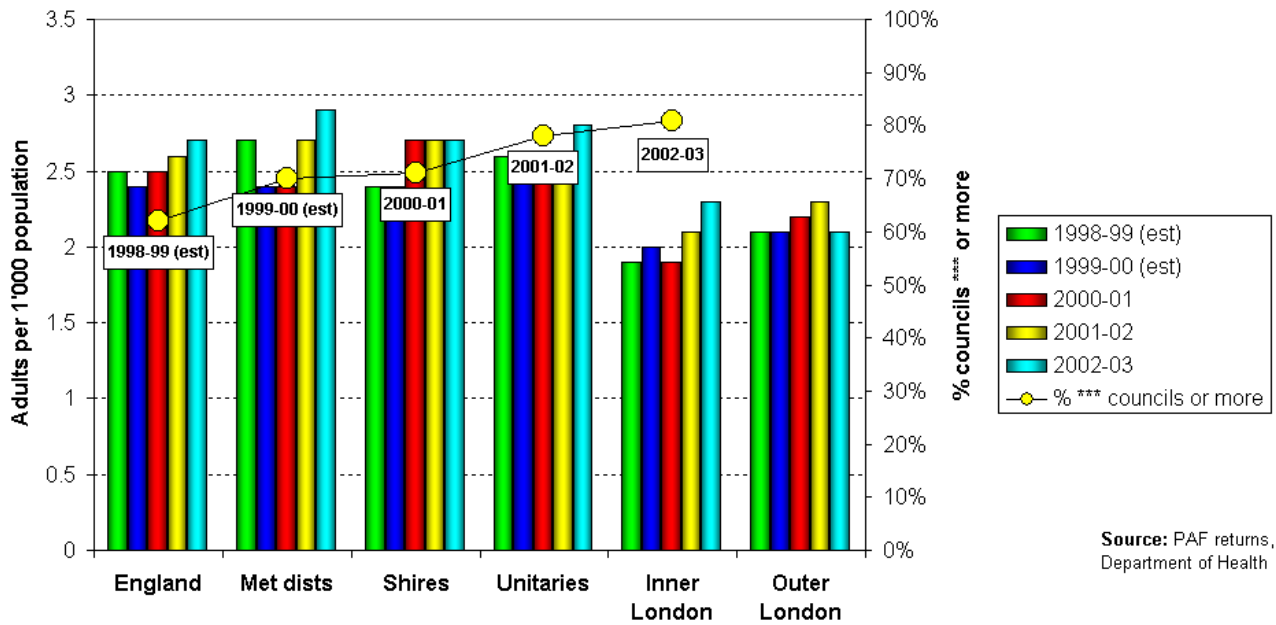


Figure 8.28 Northern Ireland: Numbers of People with Learning Disabilities Registered at Statutory Day Care Facilities at 31st March by Type of Facility 1998-1999 to 2002-2003
