- **Managing as a carer:** managing money, how services work, safety, what next?

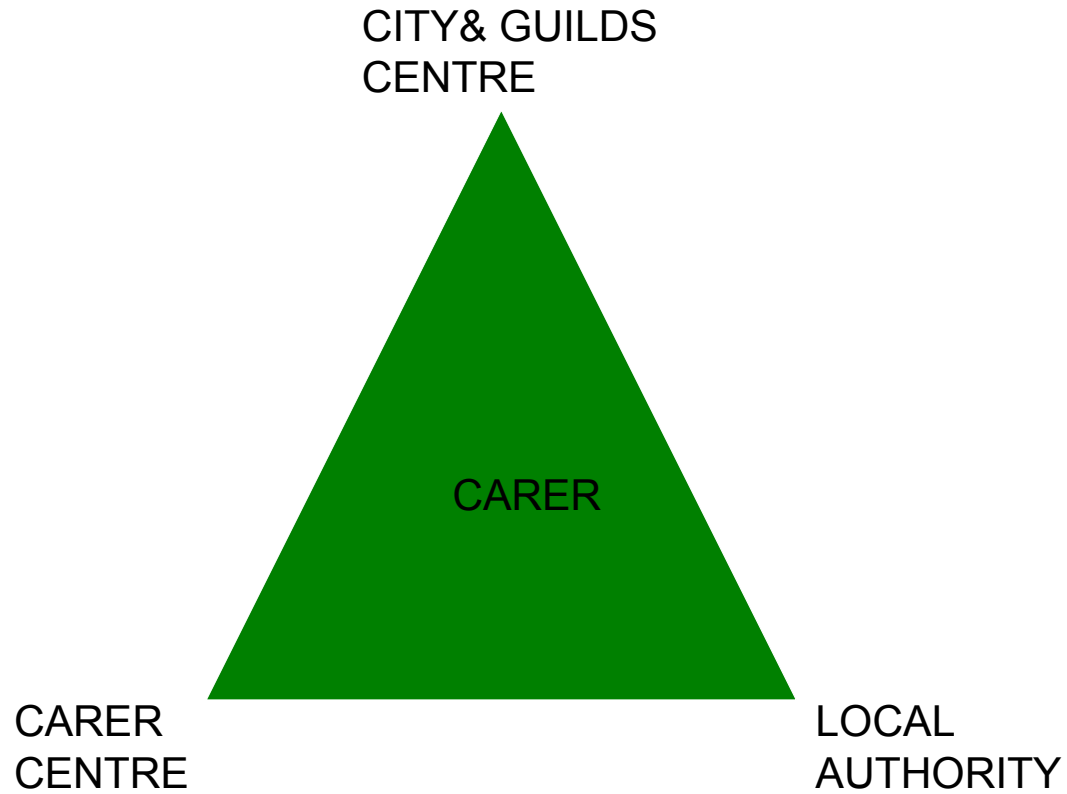
The Carers (Equal Opportunities) Act 2004

- **Carers assessments** now include education, training, leisure and work needs.
- **Co-operation between** local authorities and education bodies.
- **Carers needs to be considered** as part of other strategies, eg: welfare to work and life-long-learning.
- **Carers development officer/carers lead** appointed to look after the Carers Strategy
