- Co-production and co-payment

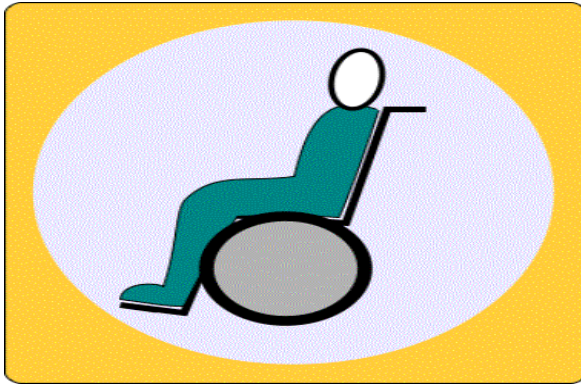

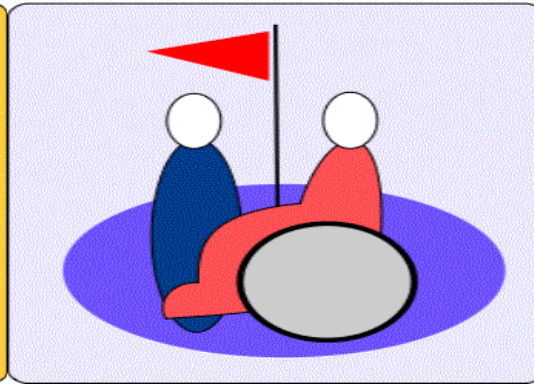
- **Local Authorities new role to 'place shape'**

  - **Supporting local and small providers**



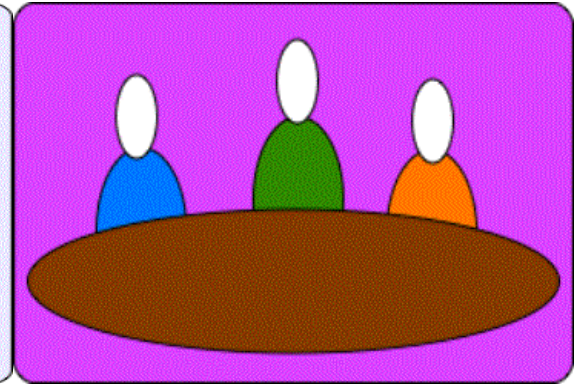
