Mrs B lives alone and usually manages with occasional help from neighbours. Today she fell over outside and couldn't get up.

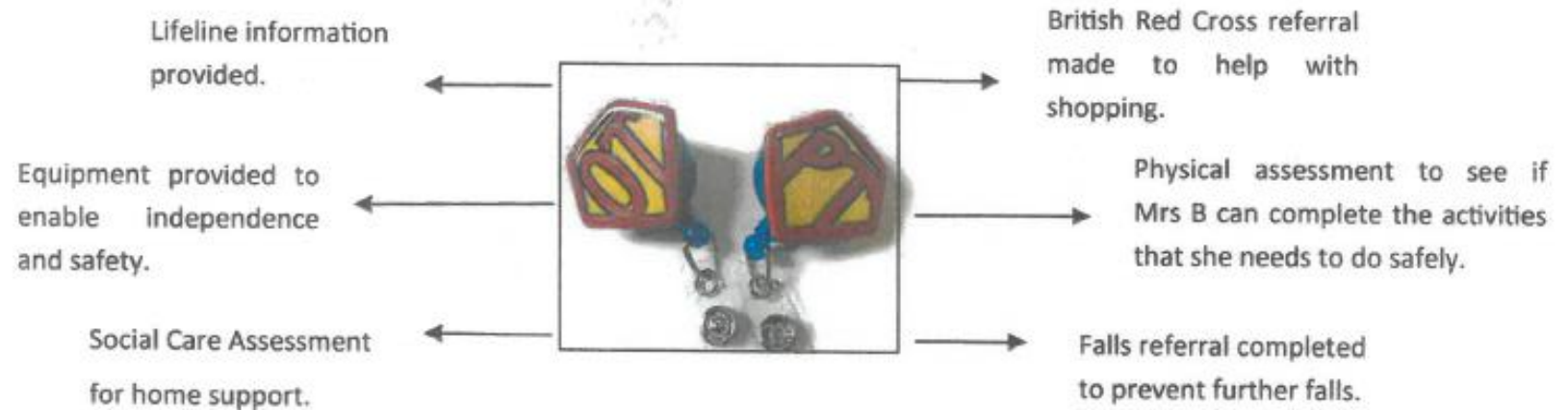


Mrs B was found by her neighbour who called an ambulance, which transported her to hospital.



Mrs B was seen by a Dr in the Emergency Department. Although Mrs B was not seriously injured there were concerns about how she would manage at home.

## To prevent admission Mrs B was assessed by the Front Door Team



The interventions provided allowed Mrs B to safely return home only 3 hours after she arrived at hospital, helping towards achieving the 4 hour target.

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The Royal College of Occupational Therapy reports therapists can reduce hospital admissions by 70-80% by working in A&E. *Reducing the pressure on hospitals (2017)*

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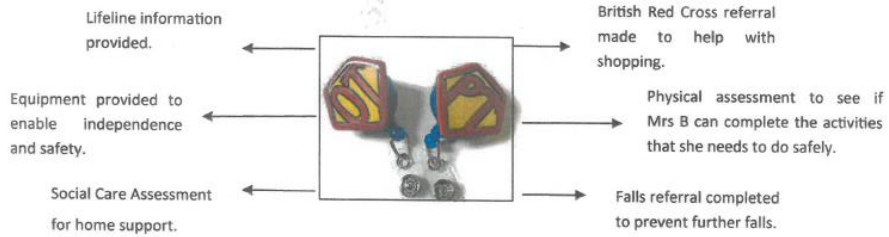


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
