Asset Mapping

- 1) What is currently known about the assets that exist in your area?
- 2) Do they know about your programme?
- 3) What discussions have taken place around working together?
- 4) How do these assets interact with each other? Do they know about each other?
- 5) How do people living with cancer (PLWC) feel about these assets – do they meet needs, do people know about them?
- 6) Do other professionals know about them?
- 7) Are there plans to bring these assets together to socialise and work out how to work together?
- 8) How are they delivering person centred, asset based support?
- 9) How do you access? Any criteria? Where do they reach? How do you get there?
- 10) What other assets do they know that need to be involved?
- 11) Are there events planned to do this?
- 12) Any training needs around cancer?
- 13) How are others assessing needs? How can we link up?
- 14) How are others sharing info/data?

Stakeholder engagement

- 1) Have stakeholders been brought together?
- 2) What do stakeholders know and understand about your programme?
- 3) What do stakeholders know and understand of assets in your area?
- 4) What do people understand of PLWC experiences?
- 5) What do they see are the barriers?
- 6) What do they think are the key enablers/solutions?
- 7) Any other stakeholders that need to be involved from their P.O.V
- 8) What do they need to help support PLWC in a holistic person-centred way?
- 9) Do they know who to speak to in GP/Primary care/Community/Acute to help join up pathways?
- 10) Do they have training needs around cancer?

Coproduction/pathway modelling

- 1) What is currently known about the pathway for PLWC? IS it different for different tumour types/groups of people etc?
- 2) How do people access information and support?
- 3) How do people access information on support/get access to assets?
- 4) What are the key issues for PLWC?
- 5) What does/would good look like?

- 6) What are the experiences for PLWC?
- 7) What or how do they think Macmillan Cancer Support or others in the system should support with?
- 8) What do people value?
- 9) What matters to PLWC?
- 10) Any assumptions and preconceptions to be challenged?
- 11) Are there particular groups of PLWC that don't access support than others?
- 12) How are we using existing infrastructure within stakeholders and wider to engage?
- 13) What events are planned?
- 14) What are the emerging solutions from the work already been done?
