- Champion the role of social work, BIAs and AMHPs within teams and as leaders within systems.
- Increased confidence to lead on securing human rights in a multidisciplinary context.
- Direct experience of solution focussed coaching/mentoring at individual level.

# Leadership Programme Stakeholders

- The main stakeholders will be Social Workers within Mental Health leadership positions and those with a leadership role in the implementation of the Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards and the Mental Capacity Act.
- Service users and carers will be consulted at the development stage of the leadership programme. The team has established links to service user educators.
