Imogen Parry – A common issue is negative attitudes between different groups, between different sectors, different professionals, and sometimes behind those negative attitudes is a lack of understanding of each other's roles, each other's remits, priorities, language and terminology even.

Sometimes housing staff report that adult social care staff don't treat them as fellow professionals and as a result fail to share information with them, fail to invite them to strategy meetings, fail to involve them in investigations, or give them follow up information following referrals or reports of concerns or alerts.
